### INSTRUCTIONS TO JUDGES

Please make sure you have read the "Instructions to Judges" sheet in your packet. Each judge should fill out his/her own critique sheet for each entry. Make at least a few comments on each sheet. Determine the winners by adding all the points given by the judges. **Double-check your addition.** Fill out the results sheet after ALL entries have been judged.

### RULES

There may be one team entry per school, with each team consisting of at least one but not more than four students. No more than one upper-level student (German III or above) may be on a team, and no advantaged speakers may be on a team. Each team may use one dictionary. Contestants will be given a map, a set of directions in German, and paper for writing answers. Vocabulary will be kept simple. Teams will be required to answer questions about objects, places, signs, etc., which can be found on the map. Answers must be written in simple but *complete* German sentences. The team who answers the most questions in the most grammatically-correct German in the 30-minute time limit will be declared the winner.

### CRITERIA FOR JUDGING

1. The content of the answers is basically correct (0-50 points).
2. The German used in the answers is grammatically accurate and makes sense, and the answers are contained in complete sentences (0-50 points).
3. In case of ties, the team finishing in the shortest amount of time is the winner (0-20 points extra credit).
